Dear Parents/Guardians,

The usual age for celebrating First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Eucharist (Communion) is age seven (when the children are in **Grade 2**). Young people who would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation usually do so around the ages of twelve and thirteen (when they are in **Grade 7**). As you know, the celebration of these sacraments is important to the life of the Church and each of its members.

If you are a registered parishioner of Our Lady Queen of the World Parish and/or live within the territorial boundary of the parish, you will need the following documents to register your child for the sacramental preparation. You may also choose to register your child with the Parish where you are currently registered or practicing your faith.

- 1. First Reconciliation and First Communion: Child's Baptismal Certificate
- 2. Confirmation: Child's Baptismal Certificate and First Communion Certificate
