Dear Parents/Guardians,

The usual age for celebrating First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Eucharist (Communion) is age seven (when the children are in **Grade 2**). Young people who would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation usually do so around the ages of twelve and thirteen (when they are in **Grade 7**). As you know, the celebration of these sacraments is important to the life of the Church and each of its members.

If you are a registered parishioner of Our Lady Queen of the World Parish and/or live within the territorial boundary of the parish, you will need the following documents to register your child for the sacramental preparation. *You may also choose to register your child with the Parish where you are currently registered or practicing your faith.*

1. First Reconciliation and First Communion: Child's Baptismal Certificate
2. Confirmation: Child's Baptismal Certificate and First Communion Certificate
